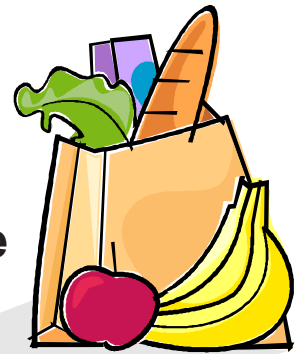

Any of the 3 Family Thrift Centers (East St. Patrick, Omaha or Bacon Park).

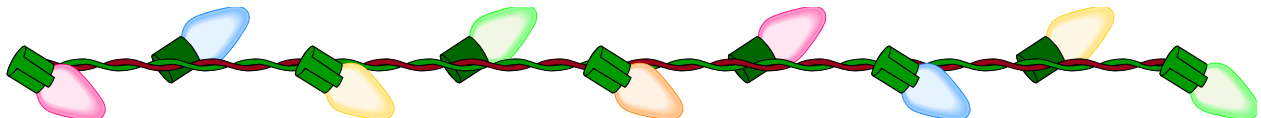

### COLLECTION AND REPORTING PROCEDURES:

- 1. Determine the weight of food your unit has collected.
- 2. Deliver it to your designated food collection agency.
- 3. Contact Frank Moser at (605)877-1137 before 2:00PM on Saturday, December 11<sup>th</sup> with the total number of participants in your unit (adult and youth) and the total weight of food collected.
- 4. Record your service hours at [www.goodturnforamerica.org](http://www.goodturnforamerica.org).

*Don't...*

**RIDE** in the back of trucks or open vehicles

**COLLECT** bags until after 9:00AM

**LEAVE** collection bags in mailboxes

**CUT** across peoples yard

*Do...*

**WATCH** carefully when crossing the street

**WEAR** your Scout uniform

**BE** courteous

**TIE** or place bags on doors

**WHAT IF OUR UNIT DOESN'T WANT TO PARTICIPATE?** The “Scouting for Food” drive is not mandatory, we encourage all Units to join in this much needed and worthwhile community service.

**DO THE BAGS HAVE TO BE DISTRIBUTED AND COLLECTED ON THE DAYS INDICATED?** The distribution day is not critical but the collection date and time are.

**CAN WE REQUEST ADDITIONAL BAGS?** Yes, as long as supplies, donated by Family Thrift, last.

**HOW DO WE DETERMINE AND RESERVE OUR COLLECTION AREA?** Rapid City Units should contact Frank Moser at the Council Office 605.342.2824 or sign-up at the November roundtable. We would like Units to keep the same collection areas as they had last year. ***The Girl Scouts will be pitching in too!***

**WHEN WILL WE RECEIVE OUR RIBBON?** January roundtable.

**HOW DO WE DETERMINE THE WEIGHT OF OUR COLLECTED FOOD?** In Rapid City, the National Guard weighs each Unit's bags. If you are outside the Rapid City limits, you may chose to weigh each bag individually or take an average weight and multiply it times the amount of bags you have collected.
